## CHAMPAGNE & PROSECCO

### Da Luca Prosecco

R400

Fresh, zingy sparkling wine – peach and apricot aromas, with a touch of sweetness and a crisp finish.

### Moët & Chandon Imperial

R1900

The delicious sumptuousness of white-fleshed fruits.

### Veuve Clicquot yellow label

R2200

Lemon richness on the nose and vanilla notes with chalky coolness and a savory, nutty finish.

### Dom Pérignon 2012

R6800

The nose is tactile, subtly enticing us along a trail of powdery white flowers and nectarous apricot, followed by the freshness of rhubarb and mint, and the minerality of ash. The taste, focused by acidic and bitter notes, the finish brings a penetrating tautness, marked by ginger, tobacco and toastiness.

## METHOD CAP CLASSIQUE

### Boschendal brut

R520

Enticing lemon cream and almond Biscotti preceding lovely layers of citrus.

### L'Omarins Brut /Rose'

R480

Raspberry and strawberry aromas with a peppery spice on the nose.

### Paul Rene Brut / Rose'

R680

Lemon richness on the nose and vanilla notes with chalky coolness and a savory, nutty finish.

## BY THE GLASS

### Da Luca Prosecco

R90

Fresh, zingy sparkling wine – peach and apricot aromas, with a touch of sweetness and a crisp finish.



## ROSE'

### De Grendel Rose'

R280

Palate is dry with a medium acidity, packed with red berry flavours, floral undertones and a crisp citrus tail.

### Rainbows end Blanc de noir

R320

The palate is light and fruity and shows dried strawberries, pomegranate and a hint of blood orange.

### Delaire franc Rose'

R460

Flavours of ripe strawberries, cassis and candy floss with a juicy, crisp and dry finish.

## SAUVIGNON BLANC

### Paul Cluver

R330

A combination of passion fruit, black current and grapefruit.

### Klein Constantia

R470

Aromas of lemon, white peach and nectarine, a wet stone minerality follows.

### Stark Conde round mountain

R590

A two-time winner of the Old Mutual Trophy and also of the FNB Top 10 Sauvignon Blanc Award. The nose is a complex mix of tropical fruits, lime and fynbos notes.

### Klein Amoskuil

R520

Beautiful zesty citrus notes shine with a saline mineral core and an ultra-long finish

## CHENIN BLANC

### Mooiplaas Roos Family

R370

Lovely pale straw colour, nose decidedly tropical with quince / golden delicious apples / litchi / mango / and summer melon flavours.

### Donkiesbaai Steen

R750

Complex aromas reveal themselves on the nose: candied lemon peel, pineapple, honeysuckle, beeswax, cream and shortbread.

### Raats

R450

Distinctive yellow apple, kiwi fruit and pineapple core, alongside notes of green melon and limes.



## CHARDONNAY

### Chamonix un-oaked

R390

intense aroma that recalls fresh citrus and tropical fruit. Bright and steely dry in flavor.

### De-wetshof finesse

R440

Strong citrus flavours with a pronounced nuttiness on the mid-palate which leads through to a clean finish with zesty citrus notes.

### Capensis Silene

R830

Notes of lemon-lime, peach, and citrus blossom, carried by a bright salinity and richly textured, mineral finish.

## WHITE BLENDS

### Rickety bridge

R380

Elegant with spring blossoms, restrained peach, mango and stone fruit on the nose. Subtle hints of oak spice and a refined fruit expression.

### Boekenhoudskloof semillon

R1060

aromas of mandarin orange, tangerine peel, pineapple and fragrant blossoms and gentle whiffs of angelica, lemon verbena, nettles and spicy oak nuances all adding intensity to the citrus character.

## WHITE BY THE GLASS

### La Motte Sauvignon blanc

R85

Gooseberry and lime accompanied by fresh lemon and winter melon.

### Franschhoek Cellars Chenin blanc

R70

Animated pineapple, fleshy peach, nectarine and honeysuckle aromas.



## CHEFS SELECTION RED BLENDS

### Holden Manz Proprietors blend

R630

This combination of Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah, delivers a perfumed nose with complementary flavours of dark and red fruits and underpinned with soft spiced.

### Taaibosch Crescendo

R890

A blend of 65% Cabernet Franc, 30% Merlot, and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon with engaging aromatics of red berries, some leafiness, and pencil shavings precede a palate that is medium-bodied with good freshness and fine, chalky tannins.

### Boschendal The Nicolas

R570

Shiraz, a signature variety for Boschendal, adds intrigue and depth with intriguing spicy notes, Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot give classical structure, Malbec a beautiful deep colour and vibrant red fruit, while the Merlot enhances the fruit profile and Cabernet Franc elaborates on the spicy richness of the Shiraz.

### Nederburg Ingenuity 2010

R920

Fully mature and leathery, with bracing, revitalising acidity. Aromas of sundried fruit and forest floor along with barrel-aged balsamic, soy and leather. The palate still has firm acidity and fine tannins, nicely framing the ripe fruit and, typical of these Italian varietals, just begging for oily food.

### Fleur Du Cap Laszlo 2019

R1100

Flagship Bordeaux-style red blend, is a rich, full-bodied wine. It shows intense aromas of cherry and red plums with hints of pencil shavings that develop into tobacco notes. The lush but firm tannins with ripe fruit flavours follow through onto the palate. Although the wine is very rich and appealing, it has wonderful length.

### Ridgeback Journey

R490

A blend of the finest Bordeaux cultivars showing intense and vibrant colour. The soft, integrated tannins and juicy mid palate runs seamlessly onto a long, mineral finish.

### Zevenwacht reserve Z

R790

A complex wine showing intense cassis, wet tobacco, blackberry and liquorice with undertones of graphite and allspice. The palate is full bodied with an elegant structure.



## MERLOT

### Overgaauw

R600

Medium-bodied wine with a rich combination of sumptuous black cherry fruit, hints of cocoa powder and elegant spicy oak notes.

### Anura

R520

Intense flavours of ripe blackberry, red berry and blackcurrant. Anura merlot famously offers hints of mint and violet aromas including subtle tones of dark chocolate and coffee.

### Maastricht

R400

The nose shows hints of the spicy characteristics of the variety, it is complemented by dark berry fruit flavours.

## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

### Tokara

R380

Aromas of cocoa, cassis and mulberries offer a nose of intense complexity with a spicy undertone of cedarwood.

### Oldenburg 2015

R1300

Brilliant red and black fruit on the nose and palate, including abundant raspberries and cherries, with hints of sage.

### Plaisir

R720

Fragrant red berries with hints of violets and mint chocolate. Black cherries and plums layered with vanilla spice, cloves and cedar oak.

## SHIRAZ/SYRAH

### Eagles nest Shiraz

R980

Savoury, spicy pallet, with aromas of star anees ,cloves and pure, clean red fruit flavours.

### Delaire Graff Shiraz

R440

A spicy white pepper undertone as well as lavender and dark red fruit aromas of mulberries.

### Iona Solace Syrah

R870

Layers of bramble and red berry fruit, with spicy, peppery aromas. A palate that emphasises floral elements.

### Zevenwacht Z Syrah

R790

Black berry and raspberry fruit with white pepper and cinnamon spice that flows onto the palate, showing succulent dark berries and a fine peppery tannins.



## PINOT NOIR

### La Brune

R480

Cherry, citrus skin and perfume with a hint of earth. Tightness, minerality and length.

### De Grendel Op die berg

R780

A plush array of fresh strawberries, ripe cherries, and a hint of forest mushrooms.

## PINOTAGE

### Kanonkop

R1350

Uplifting aromas of plums, prunes, black cherries and sweet oak spice, with integrated tannins and a pure, lingering finish.

### Doolhof mountain range

R320

A flavour explosion with dark chocolate; rich black fruit, almonds, and black cherries on the nose.

## CAB FRANC

### The Gragasjeest (Bruce)

R850

A refreshing, elegant Cabernet Franc with emphasis is on fruit rather than oak. Fresh and bright with herbal, graphite and blackcurrant leaf flavors and svelte tannins.

### Rainbows end

R470

Nuances of dark cherry, earthy, black berries, tobacco and black forest cake. There is underlying fynbos and lavender but no heavy vegetativeness.

## RED BY THE GLASS

### Haute Cabriere unwooded

R80

Enjoy an abundance of red berries and soft tannins.

### Franschhoek Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon

R75

Concentrated currants and mulberry fruit flavours, elaborated by attractive savoury oak spice.



## SOMETHING DIFFERENT

### Sanniesrust Cinsaut

R350

Young and juicy, distinguished by red and dark berries, touches of licorice, spices and herbs, good length.

### Creation Viognier

R360

The wine is delightfully forthcoming on the nose with pertinent peach snuggling up to the secret subtleties of ripe pear. These aromas find resonance on the smooth palate where apricot adds another dimension and blends seamlessly with crisp minerality and bouncy, well-integrated natural acidity.

### Telema riesling

R340

Made in off dry style, with delicious lemon fruit, hints of stony minerality, citrus blossom and a clean, crisp finish. The wine shows a delicate balance of sweetness and acidity.

### Cederberg bukettraube

R300

A perfumed nose of peach and white blossoms with subtle hints of muscat and dried apricots. Rich, opulent, mouth-coating flavours on the palate wrap your senses in exotic tastes delivering delicate sweetness and ending in a clean, lingering finish.

## DESSERT WINE

### Pierre Jourdan Ratafia

R80

A fortified, full-bodied sweet wine with hints of fresh limes together with rich honey tones.

### Donkiesbaai hooiwijn

R790

Pale gold with vivid aromas of Seville marmalade and honeycomb. Silky sweet on the palate, revealing glazed apricots, candied citrus, and a hint of fresh ginger. Finely balanced and light on the finish.
